

This book is in Serbian. The title is "Under the Six-pointed Star", and is a book exposing the influence of Judaism and Freemasonry in the past and in the modern world. It was written by Bishop Gregory Grabbe when he was still a layman known as Count Yuriy Pavlovich Grabbe, living in Belgrade, Yugoslavia. At that time, he was already secretary of the Synod of Bishops of the Russian Orthodox Church Outside of Russia, which, at that time, was headquartered in Belgrade as well. The name of the author of this book is Georgy Pavlovich. Yuriy is another form of the name George in Russian, and Pavlovich sounds like a Serbian surname, but in Russian it was Bishop Gregory's patronymic.

The original manuscript was confiscated during the Nazi occupation of Yugoslavia by the Gestapo. All printed copies of the book somehow, mysteriously, disappeared from the bookstores. This PDF file is rare indeed. It is a photocopy of one of the last known original edition copies of this book, owned by Bishop Gregory's daughter, Matushka Anastasia Georgievna Schatiloff, and left behind among her personal effects after her repose.

If anyone is able to translate this book into Russian or English, or both, it would be a great offering for the sake of the truth of Orthodoxy, and much appreciated.
